2016 League Code of Conduct

Parent's Code of Conduct

Parents are vital to the development of young athletes. Parents and adults involved in youth sports should be models of good sportsmanship and lead by example on and off the playing field. By signing this contract, you agree to follow the rules and requirements established by the organization.

- 1. Give constructive criticism during a private moment, never in front of other parents, players, officials, spectators, etc.
- 2. Support your coach and refrain from excessive "sideline coaching" from the stands.
- 3. Refrain from using profanity.
- 4. Abide by a doctor's decision in all matters of players health and injuries and physical ability to play.
- 5. Accept the decisions of officials on the field as being called to the best of their ability. Parents must stay off the field and remain under control in order to set a good example for players and other spectators.
- 6. Do not criticize an opposing team, its players, fans, coaches or team by words or gestures.
- 7. Support the coaches, players and officials and help teach the value of commitment to the teams, sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- 8. Inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate ejection from the stands. Repeat offenses will result in being barred from future games and league sponsored activities.
- 9. Parents will not encourage their child or any other person to engage in misconduct with any coach, parent, player, participants, officials or any other attendee.
- 10. Be on time to pick up your child from practices and games.
- 11. Do not comment or remark negatively about any team, coach, player, or volunteer using social media. (i.e Facebook, Twitter) This will be considered misconduct.
- 12. Refrain from fighting.
- 13. No smoking on practice or game fields. Smoking is prohibited on all Lynchburg City School properties.
- 14. Vehicles must NOT be parked on the field or track area of Lynchburg City Schools' properties.
- 15. I will not use Hill City Youth Football and Cheerleading Association or its logos in any reproduction without the written consent and full Board Approval from the Hill City Youth Football and Cheerleading Association.

Participant's Code of Conduct

- I will participate in every game and every practice, except for illness, injury, homework or school events.
- 9. I will ensure my uniform and my other gear is complete, safe, and in good condition at all times.
